Becky Edles-Rye Tournament Director

Becky grew up in Long Beach, California, in a tennis playing family and was ranked in the top 20 of each age division in Southern California. Older brother Joe is a pro at the Denver Country Club and Mike is the Head Women's Tennis Coach at University of California, Irvine (UCI) since 1996.

Also, both parents were avid players (mom still plays weekly) and headed up the family for the 2007 SCTA Family of the Year. Becky played collegiate tennis for Long Beach City College and San Diego State University. She is a certified United States Professional Tennis Association (USPTA) Pro 1 teaching pro. For 7 plus years Becky was the USTA Schools Director/Community Tennis Development for the Southern California Tennis Association/USTA Southern California. Since August of 2002, she has worked as the Executive Director of the Orange County Community Tennis Association. Becky's husband (now an avid fisherman), son and daughter all play tennis.





Michael Chang

Michael Te Pei Chang (born February 22, 1972, in Hoboken, New Jersey) played on the ATP Tour for 16 years and is best remembered for becoming the youngest ever male player to win a Grand Slam singles

title when he won the 1989 French Open at the tender age of 17. He has numerous youngest ever records including becoming the youngest male ever to win a main draw match at the US Open (15 yrs of age) as well as the youngest ever to rank in the top 5. He finished in the Top 10 of the ATP Tour world rankings for seven years, peaking at world # 2.

Chang was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame in 2008.

A devout Christian, Chang's faith was first brought to the spotlight during the 1989 French Open when he declared "I thank the Lord Jesus Christ, because without Him, I am nothing," after winning the championship. Chang and his family established the Chang Family Foundation in 1999, dedicated to integrating tennis, family and Christian faith.



Carl Chang

Carl Chang (born February 13, 1969, in Hoboken, New Jersey) is the older brother and coach of tennis star Michael Chang.

Carl was a talented junior and collegiate tennis player who recorded wins over tennis greats Pete Sampras and Andre Agassi during their younger years. Carl attended the University of California, Berkeley on a full tennis scholarship and graduated with a business degree in 1991.

Following his graduation, Carl briefly played on the professional ATP Tour before becoming Michael's coach — a pivotal move that would propel his younger brother to play some of his best years on tour. Bringing Michael to two Grand Slam finals and a career high #2 in the world, Carl was named 'Coach of the Year' by Tennis magazine in 1996.

Carl now serves as the CEO of Redwood Real Estate Partners in Rancho Santa Margarita, California.



Eliot Teltscher

Eliot Teltscher turned pro in 1979 and was a top 10 player from 1980–82. He was ranked no lower than #15 through 1984 and reached his highest career singles ATP ranking on May 7, 1982, when he became the #6 player in the world.

Looking back at his career, Teltscher showed great sportsmanship and integrity even amidst his competitive nature. During a match at the Masters Tournament against Vitas Gerulaitis, his racket grazed the net at match point. No one, including Gerulaitis, was aware of the violation except for Teltscher. Rather than let it pass, however, he informed the chair umpire of the infraction and lost the crucial point because of his honesty.

Eliot has worked with numerous tour players including Justin Gimelstob (1992 to 1997), Richey Reneberg (1997), Jeff Tarango (1995), Pete Sampras, Jim Grabb (1992) and Taylor Dent (2001). Teltscher served as the men's head tennis coach at Pepperdine University for the 1991–92 school season and was named USTA Director of Tennis Operations in December 2002.

Besides his great accomplishments as a player, he is also one of the most well respected coaches in tennis today.



Kimberly Po

Kimberly Po-Messerli (born October 20, 1971, in Los Angeles, California) is a former professional tennis player who reached a career high singles ranking of #14 in the world as well as #6 in doubles on the WTA Tour.

During her career, Kim won six top level doubles titles including the 2000 mixed doubles title at Wimbledon (partnering Donald Johnson). She was also a mixed doubles runner-up at the US Open in 1999 (partnering Donald Johnson) as well as a women's doubles runner-up at the US Open in 2001 (partnering Nathalie Tauziat).

Her best singles performance at a Grand Slam event came at the Australian Open in 1997, when she reached the quarterfinals defeating Lindsay Davenport along the way.

Kim has served as a USTA National Tennis Coach and continues to teach young aspiring players today.




Debbie Graham

Debbie Graham Shaffer (born August 25, 1970) is a former professional tennis player who played on the WTA Tour for 10 years. She reached a career high singles ranking of #28 as well as #9 in doubles.

Debbie attended Stanford University where she became the 1990 NCAA singles champion and was also inducted into the Stanford Hall of Fame in 2007.

Debbie has served as a USTA National Tennis Coach for a number of years and continues to work with top pros, juniors, and players as young as three years old.




Adam Davidson

Adam played four years of college tennis at Azusa Pacific University and as team captain in 2005, helped the Cougars win the school's first ever National Championship.

He was a three-time First Team All-American selection and he and his doubles partner were ranked #1 in the Nation for three years (2003-2005). His highest singles ranking was #14 in the country in 2003. After graduating with a bachelor's in Business, Adam turned pro and took his racquets around the world for the next two and a half years competing on the ATP tour. Davidson played two seasons of World Team Tennis for the Sacramento Capitals where he played alongside the likes of Pete Sampras, Anna Kournakova, Mark Knowles, Lindsay Davenport and the Bryan Brothers.

Adam's favorite tennis moment was winning the NAIA Team National Championship in Mobile, Alabama in 2005. His hero is Jesus Christ and his favorite tennis players are Gael Monfils, Michael Chang and the Bryan Bros. He credits much of what he has learned to his father, Bob Davidson, and his past coaches Wayne Bryan and Mark Bohren.



Robert Rye

A Long Beach, CA native, Rye joined the Coe coaching staff in the fall of 2010.

He played all four years at Whitman on a team that was consistently ranked in the top 25 of Division III (high of #12 in 2007). During that time, Rye was twice named to the ITA All-Academic team. On the court, Rye compiled a 51-16 record, one of the highest winning percentages (minimum 50 matches) of any player in school history.

Rye is a USPTA certified P2 level tennis pro. He has taught lessons for UC Irvine's campus recreation department, as well as spending the past five summers teaching at the UC Irvine junior tennis camp, acting as director of the program in 2009.



Jerry Yu

Jerry Yu was born in Houston, Texas but grew up in Southern California. He is a cousin of Michael and Carl Chang.

After graduating from UCLA in 1996, Jerry worked closely for and travelled with Michael and Carl on tour where he gained invaluable experience and insight into the game of tennis. Jerry worked for Michael and the Chang Family Foundation until 2001.

Jerry is currently an assistant tennis coach at California Lutheran University and a teaching pro with the Total Tennis Academy.

He is also the Tennis Director of the Summer Tennis Programs at Newbury Park High School and Dos Vientos Park. Jerry is a certified USPTA Professional and resides in Thousand Oaks, California with his wife, Jacy, and their three children.




